# <u>Cllr Andrew Saywell – Report to Langtree Parish Council, 14 June</u> 2018

Dear councillors,

Please accept my apologies for not being able to attend your meeting tonight. There are a number of issues I would like to update you on.

#### Tree outside Green Dragon

As you know the remedial works on the tree took place following the last Parish Council meeting. I believe the works were observed at the time by Cllrs French and Edworthy. There is little more that I can add at this stage and I am still waiting to hear back from officers as to whether the ownership of the tree can be transferred to the Parish Council.

#### **North Devon Link Road**

The County Council was successful in its £83 million funding bid to the Government to upgrade the North Devon Link Road between South Molton and Barnstaple. The funding will go towards a £93 million scheme which will widen the North Devon Link Road from South Molton to Barnstaple to provide more overtaking opportunities. Junction improvements and safety upgrades will also be carried out from South Molton to Bideford.

A planning application is now due to be submitted later this year, with a Full Business Case being submitted in 2020, which would potentially allow construction to start in late 2020.

#### **Major Road Network**

Earlier this year the Department of Transport consulted on the creation of a 'major road network'. Currently there is the strategic road network (motorways, dual carriageways etc.) and then local authority maintained roads.

The intention of creating a 'Major Road Network' would be to allow for dedicated funding from the National Roads Fund to be used to improve the middle tier of the UK's busiest and most economically important local authority 'A' roads.

The Government's initial consultation had the North Devon Link Road and the A39, along with the A380 in South Devon, classed as major roads.

Devon County Council has responded to this and requested that both the A386 from Plymouth to Bideford, and the A388 from Launceston to Landcross are included in the Major Road Network.

If accepted this will (hopefully!) boost connectivity and funding for two of Torridge's most important roads.

#### **New Deputy Leader**

As reported at the last Parish Council meeting, Cllr James McInnes who represents the Hatherleigh and Chagford Division, is the new Deputy Leader of the County Council. Cllr Rufus Gilbert is the new Cabinet Member for the Economy and Skills and has made a commitment to visit Torridge to gain a greater understanding of the issues and challenges we face in this area compared to other parts of Devon.
